

SEWER

- ◆ New accounts in Lansing are charged the base rate of 6 units for sewer
- ◆ One unit is equivalent to 750 gallons of water
- ◆ Resident usage is reviewed annually, and calculated based on average water usage for the months of December, January, February and March
- ◆ Usage is adjusted effective the June 1 billing of each year and remains in effect until reviewed the following year

Bills are mailed on or about the 5th of each month, and are due on the 25th of each month

TRASH

1. Scheduled trash pick up is **Thursday**.
2. Please place carts at the curb by **6:00 am**.
3. The rate for trash service is \$16.19 per month. A senior rate is available to those 65 and older (proof of age required).
4. Trash should be bagged, tied and placed in the cart (black lid) provided.
5. Place the carts at least 3 feet apart and 1 foot away from the curb.
6. Construction, demolition material or other large and/or heavy items should not be set out with regular trash. An additional fee for these items applies. Call 913-631-3300 to schedule a special pick up.
7. Yard waste must be in bio-degradable bags or rigid containers clearly marked "Yard Waste". The number of set-outs per week is up to eight (8) Mar-Aug and up to twelve (12) Sept-Dec. Each bag, container or bundle must weigh no more than 65 lbs.

Note: Customers may also take materials to the Leavenworth County Transfer Station. For questions regarding fees call 913-727-2858.

RECYCLING

Recycling is unlimited. Anything that doesn't fit in the cart can go in another container beside it as long as it is marked "Recycling". Place all items loosely in the cart (yellow lid) provided.
