

SEWER

- ◆ New accounts in Lansing are charged the base rate of 6 units for sewer (\$59.50).
- ◆ One unit is equivalent to 750 gallons of water usage.
- ◆ Water usage is reviewed annually to calculate the average sewer usage for each household. The months of December, January, February and March are used to calculate that average.
- ◆ Usage is adjusted effective the June 1 billing of each year and remains in effect until reviewed the following year.
- ◆ Bills are mailed on or about the 5th of each month, and are due on the 25th of each month.

TRASH

1. Scheduled trash pick up is **Thursday**.
2. Please place carts at the curb by 6:00 am.
3. The rate for trash service is \$16.19 per month. Senior rate is available to those 65 and older (proof of age required).
4. Trash should be bagged, tied and placed in the cart (black lid) provided.
5. Place the carts at least 3 feet apart and 1 foot away from the curb.
6. Construction, demolition material, or other large and/or heavy items should not be set out with regular trash. An additional fee for these items applies. Call 913-631-3300 to schedule a special pick up.
7. Yard waste must be bundled with twine, in bio-degradable bags, or in rigid containers clearly marked "Yard Waste". Residents may set out up to 12 bags/bundles/containers per week Mar 1 - Nov 30. Dec 1 - Feb 28, yard waste will be picked up on the first collection day of each month. Each bag, bundle, or container must weigh no more than 65 lbs.

Note: Customers may also take materials to the **Leavenworth County Transfer Station**. For questions regarding fees at the Transfer Station, call **913-727-2858**.

Waste Management observes the following holidays:

during a regular work week, Thursday's trash service will be delayed until Friday.

RECYCLING

Recycling is unlimited. Place items loosely in the cart (yellow lid) provided. Anything that does not fit in the cart can go in another container beside it as long as the container is marked "Recycling".
